THE HOLY MARTYRS MENODORA, METRODORA, & NYMPHODORA OF BITHYNIA

Saints Menodora, Metrodora, & Nymphodora were three Christian virgin sisters who lived together in Bithynia (now part of Turkey) in the early 300's A.D. During one of the waves of Roman pagan persecution of those times they were hauled before Roman Governor Fronto to be tried. He first tried to persuade them to deny Christ and worship pagan gods by using gentle words. He got nowhere. Then he resorted to violent torture. Menodora was beaten with rods but wouldn't give in. This angered the governor so much that he had her beaten to death with a club. Metrodora was hung up and burned slowly with torches which finally killed her after 2 hours. Nymphodora was hung up and her flesh torn with iron hooks. She responded with prayer. The governor then had her beaten to death with clubs. All three remained faithful to Christ, no matter what the governor did. Their martyrdoms took place on September 10, 305 A.D.


