ST. TIKHON OF ZADONSK

St. Tikhon, whose memory we celebrate today, was born near Novgorod, Russia in 1724. He grew up in great poverty but did manage to go to seminary. He became a monk and later was made priest and eventually bishop. He had a very difficult diocese (Voronezh) work in. There was much drunkenness, quarrelsome clergy, almost no preaching, lax following of church traditions, etc. He worked so hard that after some years his health was badly affected and he had to retire to a monastery at Zadonsk. There he lived a quiet life of prayer and became a close friend and helper to the local peasants and poor. He was greatly loved by all the people of the area and became a powerful spiritual teacher due to his very close walk with Christ. He died peacefully on August 13, 1783 A.D. and was canonized in 1861.


