

THE HOLY FATHERS OF THE FIRST ECUMENICAL COUNCIL

The Sunday before Pentecost is set aside every year in the Orthodox Church to venerate the Holy Father of the First Ecumenical Council in the city of Nicea in 325 A.D. Called together by the first Christian emperor, St. Constantine, the main purpose of the Council was to oppose the huge Arian heresy which denied the divinity of Jesus. Inspired by the Holy Spirit, they wrote most of the Creed we recite at each liturgy (the details about the Holy Spirit were added later at the Second Ecumenical Council). Many of the bishops that met at this Council were men who had suffered greatly under the Roman persecutions of the Church but had not died. It is said that Emperor Constantine was so emotionally moved by their presence that he went around the room and kissed their wounds in veneration. The two most famous Saints attending were St. Nicholas and St. Athanasius, who was still a deacon in 325.

ST. DOROTHEOS, BISHOP OF TYRE

St. Dorotheos was the bishop of Tyre in Lebanon in the 300's A.D., who is commemorated on June 5th, the date of his death. He was a great scholar, fluent in Greek, Hebrew, and Latin. He was a member of the First Ecumenical Council at Nicea in 325 A.D. (and so is actually twice commemorated today---see above). He suffered greatly during the huge persecution of the Church by Emperor Diocletian, and also went through many troubles in the much later reign of Julian the Apostate. But he finally fell asleep in Christ peacefully at age 107.

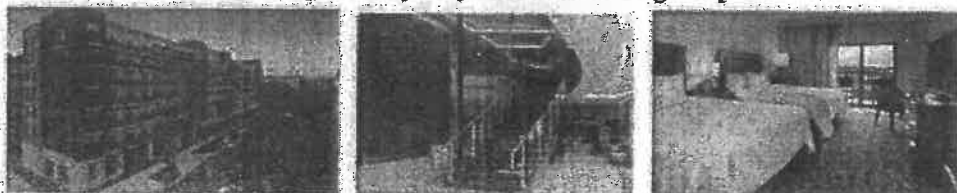

He hath subdued peoples under us, and the nations under our feet. God is gone up in jubilation, the Lord with the voice of the trumpet.

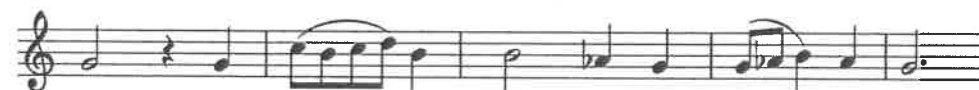

VERSES OF THE THIRD ANTIPHON

Hear this, all ye nations; give ear, all ye that inhabit the world. My mouth shall speak wisdom; and the meditation of my heart shall be of understanding. I will incline mine ear unto a parable; I will unfold my problem on the psaltery. (*now sing the Apolytikion of the Ascension*)

THE EISODIKON (ENTRANCE HYMN) OF ORDINARY SUNDAYS

Come, let us worship and fall down before Christ. Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

RESURRECTIONAL APOLYTIKION IN TONE SIX (p. 14)

When Mary stood at Thy grave, looking for Thy sacred body, angelic powers shone above Thy revered tomb. And the soldiers who were to keep guard became as dead men. Thou led Hades captive

and wast not tempted thereby. Thou didst meet the Virgin and didst give life to the world, O Thou, Who art risen from the dead, O Lord, glory to Thee.

APOLYTIKION OF THE ASCENSION IN TONE FOUR

Thou hast ascended in glory, O Christ our God, and gladdened Thy disciples with the promise of the Holy Spirit; and they were assured by the blessing that Thou art the Son of God and Redeemer of the world.

APOLYTIKION OF THE HOLY FATHERS IN TONE EIGHT

Most glorified art Thou, O Christ our God, Who hast established our Fathers as luminous stars upon the earth, and through them didst guide us all to the true Faith. O Most Merciful One, glory be to Thee.

APOLYTIKION OF ST. MATTHEW THE EVANGELIST IN TONE THREE (p. 16)

With zeal you followed Christ the Master, Who in His goodness appeared to men on earth. He called you from the custom house, revealing you to be a chosen apostle, a trumpet proclaiming the Gospel to the whole world! Therefore, divinely eloquent Matthew, we honor your precious memory. Entreat the merciful God, that He may grant us remission of our sins.

KONTAKION OF THE ASCENSION IN TONE SIX

When Thou hadst fulfilled Thy dispensation for our sakes, uniting things on earth with the Heavens, Thou didst ascend in glory, O Christ our God, departing not hence, but remaining inseparable from us and crying unto them that love Thee: "I am with you, and no one can be against you."

THE EPISTLE

Blessed art Thou, O Lord, the God of our Fathers. For Thou art just in all Thou hast done to us.

The Reading from the Acts of the Apostles. (20:16-18, 28-36)

In those days, Paul was determined to sail past Ephesus, so that he might not have to spend time in Asia; for he was hastening, if possible, to be at Jerusalem on the Day of Pentecost. And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called to him the priests of the church. And when they came to him, he said to them: "Take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you bishops, to shepherd the church of the Lord and God, which He purchased with His own blood. For I know that after my departure ravenous wolves will enter among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore, remain watchful, remembering that for three years I did not cease to admonish every one, night and day with tears. And now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities, and to those who were with me. In all things I have shown you that by such laboring we ought to help the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how He Himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'" And when he had spoken thus, he knelt down on his knees with them all, and prayed.

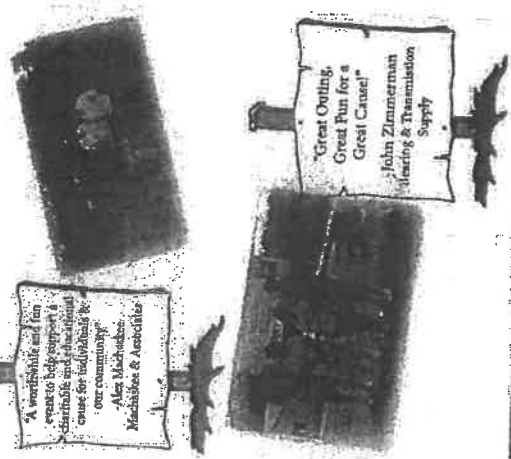

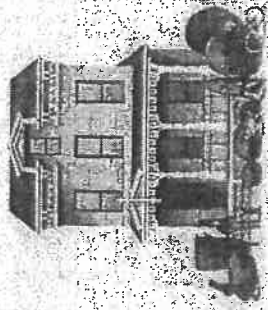

St. Herman House has been a place of refuge in Ohio City since 1977. Our mission is to shelter and support homeless men on the path to well-being and independence and meet the basic needs of people in our community.

2021 Highlights:

- Lunch & dinner for the community, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. More than 33,000 meals served.
- 63 men sheltered in our emergency shelter and transitional houses.
- Sandwiches, clothing, hygiene-items, fresh food and other basic needs provided to the community every week.
- 53 clients received case management services. Our full-time social worker provides case management to help residents find housing, access medical and behavioral health care, addiction counseling, employment, and more.
- More than 170 people assisted to obtain ID documents free of charge.
- 45% of transitional house residents worked full-time, on average; 28% of shelter residents had part-time or temp employment, on average; 17% had full-time employment, on average.
- Farm program - Agricultural program on our farm in Trumbull County with a thriving beekeeping operation. Our vision is to build a recovery ranch on the farm for men recovering from addiction and to provide workforce development programs.

THE GOSPEL

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. John. (17:1-13)

At that time, Jesus lifted up His eyes to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Thy Son that the Son may glorify Thee, since Thou hast given Him power over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom Thou hast given Him. And this is eternal life, that they know Thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ Whom Thou hast sent. I glorified Thee on earth, having accomplished the work which Thou gavest Me to do; and now, Father, glorify Thou Me in Thy own presence with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was made. I have manifested Thy Name to the men whom Thou gavest Me out of the world; Thine they were, and Thou gavest them to Me, and they have kept Thy word. Now they know that everything that Thou hast given Me is from Thee; for I have given them the words which Thou gavest Me, and they have received them and know in truth that I came from Thee; and they have believed that Thou didst send Me. I am praying for them; I am not praying for the world but for those whom Thou hast given Me, for they are Thine; all Mine are Thine, and Thine are Mine, and I am glorified in them. And now I am no more in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to Thee. Holy Father, keep them in Thy Name, which Thou hast given Me, that they may be one, even as We are one. While I was with them, I kept them in Thy Name, which Thou have given Me; I have guarded them, and none of them is lost but the son of perdition, that the scripture might be fulfilled. But now I am coming to Thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves."

- *Megalynarion: "It is Truly Meet"; Koinonikon (Communion Hymn): "Praise ye the Lord."*

Instead of singing "We have seen the true light", sing the Apolytikion of the Ascension.

FEASTING & FASTING---Being that the 40 days of Pascha have passed, we are now back to the usual Wednesday & Friday fasting. *However*, the week after Pentecost Sunday (June 12) is a fast-free celebration week.

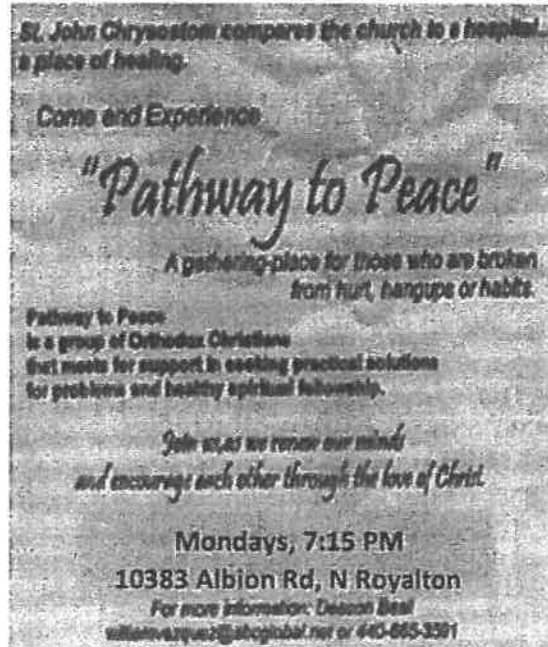
