OUR CHURCH FAMILY MEET-UP

On May 14, 1959, Lori Mae Goldfuss was born in Cincinnati, joining two sisters and one brother. Her dad served during World War II in the Air Force, dropping bombs on the Nazis in Germany. After the war he had a plumbing company. Lori's mother was a homemaker.

One day after she had graduated from high school, Lori told her father she was going to a disco that evening at the University of Cincinnati. Her dad forbade her to go, saying, "What if Jesus comes tonight? Do you want Him finding you at a disco?" Lori went anyway. While sitting down at a table, Lori and her girlfriend noticed a young man coming into the dancehall who was carrying an umbrella. The man approached them and asked her friend to dance. She refused but told him that her friend Lori would dance with him. Lori kicked her friend under the table, but when the man asked Lori to dance, she gladly accepted. This man turned out to be Norman Fadil. (For those who didn't know Norm, he was Jean Fadil and Elle Parker's nephew.) One of the things that Lori loved about her husband was he never gossiped or said anything bad about anybody.

Lori grew up in the Lutheran church. There she was baptized as a baby and was confirmed when she was 14. Both of her parents were very religious and never missed church on Sunday. Lori taught Sunday School when she was in high school.

In 1979, Lori and Norm were married at her Lutheran church in Cincinnati. The next month they had an Orthodox wedding at St. George Orthodox Church in Cleveland. That was to be their home parish. The couple had two daughters—Julie born in 1981 and Jamie born in 1983. They made their home in Berea.

In 2004, Lori started attending Grace Church in Middleburg Heights. This church had lots of classes and fellowship groups. She was thirsting for knowledge about God and His Word. Grace seemed to be what she was looking for.

Norm and Lori were blessed with two grandchildren (from Julie). Lorionna was born in 2017 and Jackson was born in 2018. These two children became the joy of their life. They were baptized into the Orthodox church with Norm serving as Lorionna's godfather, and at this time they are faithful attenders of St. Matthew's and our Sunday School.

One day in 2020, Lori was at Grace Church participating in a group, when suddenly she strongly felt God telling her that He did not want her to continue at Grace Church. She felt Him urging her to go to St. Matthew's.

Shortly after that experience, her aunt, Elle Parker, called her and asked if she could bring a fruit tray to the next coffee time at St. Matthew's. She agreed and felt like this was a confirmation for her to switch churches. On Sunday morning, she got ready to go, carrying her tray and taking Lorionna with her when Jackson started begging her to take him too. She didn't know how she could handle both kids, but didn't want to refuse her grandson, so she brought him along. Lori said that as soon as she entered the hall, Gail Malaniak swooped down on her, giving the kids worship bags and taking the whole family under her wing. This deeply touched Lori, along with noticing how the other members helped those with small children. She felt it was just like a family.

Meanwhile, around this time, Norm had been having problems with his knees. This forced him to take an early retirement and then get in line for knee replacement surgery. In June of 2021 Norm was vaccinated for COVID. The following month he developed A fib. In October he got very sick with COVID. The knee replacement was delayed until they could get the A fib and reoccurring congestive heart failure under control. He was finally able to have the knee replacement surgery in January of 2023. However, he developed sepsis and passed away on May 1, 2023.

His death was unexpected and Lori had a hard time. But her faith in Jesus has gotten her through, although it is still not easy. She loved going to Pathways to Peace and found solace in her shared pain with others. Lori says, "I know God was looking out for me when he moved me from Grace to St. Matthew's because He knew what was ahead and that I would need the love and support of people who really cared."

Lori loves to read, walk in the park and take care of her grandchildren. I have come to know her as an upbeat person who is quick to share her kindness and love with others. Her goal in life is to see her two grandchildren grow up at St. Matthew's and be good and faithful followers of Jesus Christ.


