ST. PIMEN THE GREAT

St. Pimen was born in Egypt in the 400's A.D. At age 15, he fled his home, along with his 6 brothers, to become a monk in the desert. Desert tribe raids forced them to end up living in a very isolated area, Terenuth, in a deserted pagan temple. After some time, others joined the seven brothers in their new monastery. Pimen is Greek for "shepherd" and he was a very wise shepherd over his monks. He was known for incredible personal strictness with fasting, little sleep, etc., but was also known for exercising great patience and kindness with the monks under his care. A man of great God-inspired wisdom, many traveled him seeking prayers and guidance. His exact year of death is unknown, but it is said his falling asleep in Christ took place on August 27, sometime late in the 400's, and that he was very, very old.


